1. Temos Classification Rehabilitation Centers

Physical medicine and rehabilitation (PM&R) is a medical specialty concerned with the prevention, diagnosis, evaluation, and management of persons of all ages with physical and/or cognitive impairment and disability. This specialty involves diagnosis and treatment of patients with painful or functionally limiting conditions, the management of comorbidities and co-impairments, diagnostic and therapeutic injection procedures, electrodiagnostic medicine, and emphasis on prevention of complications of disability from secondary conditions.

Rehabilitation of neurologic disorders, the diagnosis and management of impairments of the musculoskeletal (including sports and occupational aspects) and other organ systems, and the long-term management of patients with disabling conditions are parts of treatment in rehabilitation. Multidisciplinary teams work with the patients for a maximal restoration or development of physical, psychological, social, occupational and vocational functions in case abilities have been limited by disease, trauma, congenital disorders or pain to enable people to achieve their maximum functional abilities.

Measures used for rehabilitation and treatment are based on the respective diagnosis. Besides others, they include electromyography, electrotherapy, therapeutic exercise, or pharmaceutical pain control.

In the frame of the Temos “Quality in International Rehabilitation Care” program we differentiate between:

1. Acute care hospital with rehabilitation facilities
2. Hospital for in- and outpatient rehabilitation
3. Hospital for in-patient rehabilitation
4. Clinic for out-patient rehabilitation

A further differentiation applies regarding the specialties offered for rehab patients:

- Orthopedics including rheumatologic, trauma surgical, sports medical and orthopedic indications
- Cardiology, internal medicine and diabetology
- Neurology Phase B, C, D
- Dermatology
- Oncology
- Pulmonary Diseases
- Urology
- Mentally disturbances, psychosomatic and dependence rehabilitation
- Child and adolescent rehabilitation
- Geriatric rehabilitation
- Others

In the frame of the application process Temos provides a questionnaire asking for the different specializations of the rehab center. According to the respective fields of activities the certification program for your rehab facility is compiled and provided.

For the calculation of the days and assessors needed for the on-site visit we further classify regarding the number of beds available for in-patients:

- No in-patient beds
- < 20 beds
- 20 – 150 beds
- > 150 beds
